TAIAO ARONUI

- One of the three baskets of knowledge, the basket of aroha, peace, arts & crafts that benefit all living things. This basket relates to knowledge acquired through careful observation of the environment. Taiao Aronui is based around detailed observation of our local environment.

E WHĀ NGĀ KAUPAPA WĀNANGA

- Taiao Aronui involves four kaupapa wānanga. Each wānanga has been designed to explore how we embed Mātauranga Māori connected to our unique Ngāti Whakaue/ Te Arawa narratives and environment. Kaiako will be given opportunities to restore, renew and revitalise their practice enabling them to become leaders within the fields of Putaiao/ Science and Mātauranga Māori.





WHĀINGA MATUA KEY OUTCOMES

- Embedding Mātauranga Māori into the curriculum (our narrative)
- Enhancing the delivery and development of Pūtaiao within our kura
- Developing localised curriculum (Whakauetanga, Te Arawatanga)
- Shifting teacher practice (restore, renew, revitalisation of our practice)
- Ngāti Whakaue/ Te Arawa knowledge disseminated to tamariki in the rohe

'Following the whakapapa of our local water sources, kaiako will be taken on a journey with our key experts from Te Rotoruanui a Kahu, through the Ohau Channel, out to the Okere and Kaituna reaching through to where fresh water meets the sea, ki te kuraetanga o te ihu a Tametekapua.

3 KAUPAPA TUATORU TE WAONUI A TĀNE - OUR FORESTS

July 2022 - Date TBC, 3 days

'From native forests and species, through to developing forestry, forest genetics, wood products, wood derived materials and bio-material this kaupapa will see kaiako discovering the amazing connections of our natural environment to new and cutting edge innovation within the field.

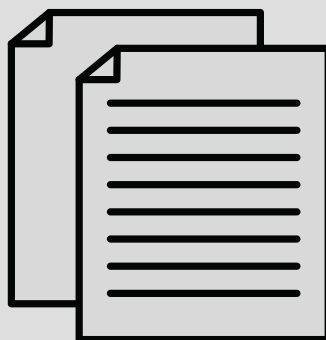
