A lot of changes coming up. Expect ORCID to be a low priority.

4. Update from Royal Society Te Apārangī
  - a. ORCID promotion at eResearch Conference
    - Tifany attended the eResearch conference in Christchurch and gave an ORCID presentation.
    - Built new relationships and engaged in productive discussions

- Visited Lincoln University and presented ORCID to a well-represented group within research leadership.
- Lincoln University presented their work on integrating OJS with ORCID.
- b. NZ ORCID Consortium Drop-in Event
  - Opportunity for members to drop in and chat
  - Offered every 4 months
- c. Support to consortia members
  - Continuing to support consortium members, especially with ORCID Hub.
  - E.g., Auckland Museum: one-on-one tutorials to help set up and use ORCID Hub.
- d. New ORCID work types
  - ORCID released new humanities and arts worktypes which will allow many more research contributions to be included
  - Need to update NZ ORCID hub with the new worktypes
- 5. New technical support for ORCID hub maintenance required: we've engaged an alternative provider.
- 6. Terms of Reference for the NZ ORCID Consortium advisory committee
  - Current Terms of reference expired in December 2024 and we need to refresh it.
  - Suggest to renew until end of current contract.
  - Consider chair role: Marie endorsed to continue as chair.
  - "A representative from the Māori and Pacific research sector": Proposed a separate Pacific representative.
  - Is there an international template?
  - Proposed to change from "have a representative from funding agency" to "agencies". TEC representative would be helpful.
  - Note that MBIE reports are annual.

  - Last meeting's action done: Update to Minister on ORCID was brought up to investment team.
  - Symplectic Elements/Digital Science (subscription service) proof of concept done. Minister agreed to go ahead with full build.
